## Introduction

Mam Humanitarian Foundation (MHF) is a non- governmental, non- profit organization with a moral personality. It works to protect individuals and or groups whom are affected by poverty, conflict, and disasters. Based on the principles of human rights and fundamental freedom, the foundation aims to educate, and capacity build the community about various different fields that include “economics, political, legal, health, educational, agricultural, environmental, tourism, and sports”. The foundation launched operations in 2019 and worked tirelessly to protect people from the crisis, especially focusing on the Covid-19 pandemic.

## Offering assistance to Hogr Badran Hassan

Following the conflict in 2012 and 2013 many Syrian people have been forced to flee and settle within the souring countries. Majority of the Syrian refugee are of Kurdish ethnicity and currently are refuge in Iraq. Approximately 98.8% of the Syrian refugees in Iraq are registered within the Kurdistan Region in Erbil, Sulaymaniyah, and Duhok governorates.

Under the slogan of “**peace, development, and coexistence**”, MHF offered assistance to **Hogr Badran Hasan** on the 19<sup>th</sup> of December. Hogr is A Syrian refugee whom lives in Arbat Camp in the city of Sulaymaniyah. He graduated from the department of philosophy- University of Tishreen. He is married and has one child. They came to Iraq due to the war, and tough condition of living in Syria.

Hogr participated in a Repair and maintenance of mobile cell phones training course. The course lasted for 40 days and covered the technical side of repairing mobile phones and computers. Those whom participated in the course, had practical lessons every day. Hogr said “it is my dream to be proficiency in Information Technology, I will try my best and put all my efforts to make my dream job come true. Although, I face some issue while talking to people, because I am not a fluent Kurdish speaker. But despite all this, I enjoy my time being here, and get benefit from the lessons. Previously, I worked on selling broad beans in the street. But now I have the ability to work in other sectors as well. I want to have an electronics repair shop in order to serve people in the society and repair cell phones and other task related to technology”.

The objective of this assistance was to allow Hogr to learn a new skill that in the future can be useful as it would mean he could potentially be more financially independent. This also allowed Hogr to be able to broaden his horizon and start the process of making his dreams come true.



## Sponsoring a sports conference

Sulaymaniyah Governorate is the lead of sport activities in the KRG and Iraq, though when it comes to the football, more steps are needed to be able to take this further. Due to this reason MHF sponsored a sport conference held by the Olympic Football Committee in Sulaymaniyah, for six Olympic football teams on the 19<sup>th</sup> of January 2021. The main objective of this seminar was to conduct and build 5 football stadiums in KRG, it also focused on how these stadiums can help and improve the skills of more than 6,000 football players in Kurdistan.



## Provision PPE to Kirkuk governorate in response to Covid-19 Pandemic

The world suffers from a new virus called Covid-19, and WHO informed that this disease is pandemic, and it is a disease caused by SARS- CoV2, Coronavirus emerged in December 2019. Covid-19 has caused millions of deaths around the world as well as lasting health problems in some who survived the illness. MHF in response to Coronavirus, distributed “50.000” masks to Hawija institute and Kirkuk education directorate on the 26<sup>th</sup> of January 2021.



## The travels of Xuncha and Adan’s magazine

In order to enhance and develop the traditional sectors within the Kurdish community and encouraging reading. MHF published a children magazine under the title of “**The travels of Xuncha and Adan/ Gashtakay Xunchaw Adan**”.



As the first step the foundation started to distribute “15,000” edition of the magazine for children in Iraq in general and especially in Kurdistan Region. The Travels of Xuncha and Adan is a children’s magazine that aims to educate children on the different aspects of Kurdish “history, geography, traditions and culture”. Xuncha and Adan are two Kurdish children whom travel to different locations.



Through this process of traveling, they are introduced to the history of each place that they travel to, the influential figures, traditional food and games, the wild animals and birds of Kurdistan. The distribution process of the magazine is currently ongoing.

MHF on the 18<sup>th</sup> of February 2021 took on the responsibility of renovating and reconstructing the central library of Qaradakh, this particular library is well known for its many visitors.





### Provide stationary to the Schools of Sulaymaniyah Governorate

MHF follows a specific life cycle to be able to successfully implement projects and activities, under the slogan of “peace, development, and coexistence” on the 21<sup>st</sup> of February 2021”MHF started the process of distributing stationery for 10 schools and directorates including, “Sport Education Institute of Sulaymaniyah, Sharbazher education directorate, secondary school of Shahid Qyady Ibrahim Ezu, Kosaran high school for boys, Zheer mixed high school, Akhjalar mixed high school, Akhjalar primary school, Qalla sewka primary school, Baryka primary school, and Qamishly primary school”.

Subsequently, education can assist with creating more lit rerate people within society. MHF on the 25<sup>th</sup> of February 2021 renovated Eastern Sulaymaniyah Directorate of Educational supervisory. This particular directorate works to supervise teachers to improve the quality of education.



## World Theatre Day

Each year on the 27<sup>th</sup> of March, World Theatre Day is celebrated on a global scale, it aims to promote art across the world. MHF on the 27<sup>th</sup> of March 2021 in partnership with Kurdistan Artists Syndicate Sulaymaniyah branch, published a book of Trifa Karimian under the title of “zor dur zor qull/ so far, so deep”. 500 editions of this book were distributed within the Kurdistan Region.

An event was held for Trifa Karimian to present her book to an audience. Trifa karimian is an Iranian female writer born on 1983 in Saqz, whom graduated at department of literature -university of Surah in Taran. Trifa has participated in many international and local competitions and has won multiple prizes. She was selected as one of the most excellent poets in Iran and Kurdistan, as well as, participated in Lion Prize in France, for two consecutive years.

## Tourism Awareness, and its Impact on the economy training course

The tourism industry can have many impacts on the economy, environment, and social aspects. Therefore, it is vital that those whom live within a tourist filled community have an appropriate amount of knowledge on such topic.

To be able to improve the tourism sectors within Kurdistan and increase awareness of the consumers. MHF in cooperation with Dukan Polytechnic Institute on the 1<sup>st</sup> of march 2021 launched a



training course under the title of “Tourism awareness, and its impact on the economy”. This course was for one month. Eleven employees with different proficiency attended this training course.

The main objective of the course was to focus on identifying and improving the tourism industry knowledge in general, and mainly on tourism ceremonies and useful tactics. This course was taught by two professional lecturers whom are experienced with teaching tourism awareness and its impact on economy in general. Thus, all the platforms that are essential have been covered and included within the training curriculum.

## Food Aid Distribution “Thanks for your efforts”.

In the light of improving the life style of workers in different sectors especially those who are working tirelessly at municipality directorates. MHF in coordination with Sulaymaniyah directorate of municipality launched the operation of offering food aid baskets under the title of “Thanks for your efforts”. Aiming to provide humanitarian assistance to gardeners, and municipality workers at



municipality directorate, and environmentalists in the Sulaymaniyah governorate on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of March 2021.

MHF prepared a suitable food basket composed of the needy items of families, it was comprised of 10kg Rice, 2kg white bean, 2kg lentils, 1kg chickpeas, 2-liters of oil, 1kg burgle, 2kg tomato paste and 200g vermicelli. The food parcels were distributed among all the municipality, gardeners and environmentalist families in Sulaymaniyah Governorate and the surrounding areas. During these a total 2,500 families benefited from this program.

Regarding the campaign of “Thanks for your efforts” MHF wants to help and support vulnerable people live in Sulaymaniyah and the surrounding areas. For this reason, MHF distributed 750 food aid baskets for 750 vulnerable families in the city of Sulaymaniyah.



## Supporting the elderly home

On 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2021 the head of Mam Humanitarian Foundation (MHF) Mr. Lahur Sheikh Jangi



Talabany in the city of Sulaymaniyah met a number of (mothers and fathers) from the elderly home, where he had breakfast with them, and promised them that he will help and support them in providing their needs through (MHF). As MHF will continue to hold activities and projects within this specific sector and area.

## Computer basics

### intermediate training course

MHF on the 4<sup>th</sup> of march 2021 launched a computer training course for “15” employees who work at Sulaymaniyah central library for the duration of one month at the Central Library. The courses required a moderate amount of previous computer experience and some knowledge about operating systems. In this course the employees learned how to create, edit, and format professional- looking charts, so that they could present complex data in a way that was meaningful to its audience. Another objective of this course included, learning how to create tables from scratch or from existing text, also learning how to change a table size, position, and style, as well as how to sort a table’s contents. At the end of the course the participants received reliable certification.



## International Women's Day

International Women's Day is a global holiday celebrated annually on March the 8<sup>th</sup> to commemorate the cultural, political, and socioeconomic achievements of women all around the world. Focusing on women's rights movements, bringing attention to issues such as "gender equality, reproductive rights, and violence and abuse against women". On this day "150" women and



girls from various and different backgrounds participated in multiple art and entertainment-related activities which were organized by MHF.

## Signing a MOU with Sardam Foundation for publishing and distribution



For the purpose of developing current intellectual movement. MHF signed a Memorandum Of Understanding (MOU) on the 9<sup>th</sup> of March 2021 with Sardam Foundation for publishing and distribution. The MOU aims to build a larger community of readers through encouraging reading different books such as "peace", developing and increasing knowledge about different aspects of its society, and self- motivations". both parties will support and develop agricultural sectors in the future stages.

### 33rd anniversary of the chemical attack in Halabja

The Halabja chemical attack, also known as the Halabja Massacre or Bloody Friday, was a massacre of Kurdish people that took place on the 16<sup>th</sup> of March 1988. Under the slogan “peace, development, and coexistence” MHF on the 16<sup>th</sup> of March 2021, announced the campaign of planting more than 5.000 young trees under the title of “Reliving”. This campaign aimed to make a positive impact on the environment, people’s lives, and creating a more sustainable community. Five thousand young trees symbolized the soul of five thousand people who were killed during the chemical attack in Halabja. Another aspect of this campaign was to increase Halabja’s Green areas.



### Sponsoring Rawan’s team in Hult prize

On the 20<sup>th</sup> of march 2021, MHF sponsored the representative student’s team of Sulaymaniyah University in the competition Hult Prize. Which is an annual, yearlong competition that selects ideas from university level students after challenging them to solve a pressing social issue around topics such as food, security, water access, energy, and education.

The prize was a partnership between Hult international business school and the United Nations Foundation. This group of students represented Sulaymaniyah University, they were 4 students, that have different proficiency. Rawan’s team wanted to solve one pressing social issue about food security in Kurdistan by opening a restaurant under the title “All in One”. For the purpose of cooperating and helping with the implementation process of agricultural projects, with some exemplary farmers in Kurdistan, they wanted to ensure that people in different area have healthy and excellent quality food to consume.





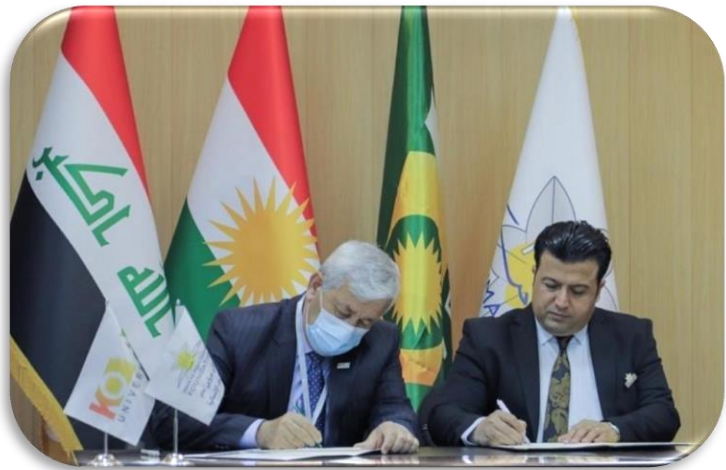
## World Down Syndrome Day

On the 21<sup>st</sup> of March 2021, MHF in collaboration with down syndrome center in Sulaymaniyah celebrated world down syndrome day, more than 100 children diagnosed with downs syndrome in the city of Sulaymaniyah participated. In December 2011, the General Assembly declared the 21<sup>st</sup> of march as world down syndrome day. This day was celebrated by MHF with those children whom are diagnosed with Downs Syndrome and their families, gifts and presents were given to the children and the day was filled with different activities allowing them to spend a remarkable day.



## Signing a MOU with University of Koya

On the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2021, at University of Koya- faculty of engineering, a MOU was signed between MHF and The University of Koya, in an effort to consolidate and support scientific and academic development. The MOU allows and encourages general principles of mutual cooperation in the field of education and coordination, the joint programs in the field of academic and scientific sector with the aim of capacity building and supporting researchers. Both parties will support each other with enhancing the quality of education, conducting collaborative seminars and workshops in the area in the frame of capacity building and development.



## Sponsorship of an international workshop

On the 31<sup>st</sup> of March 2021, in Koya University - Faculty of Engineering, an international workshop was held by the Faculty of Engineering to present the topic of refurbishing Qishla of Koya, under the title “Qishla of Koya, architectural and construction conditions: problems and solutions”. Many professors in the field of heritage conservation in the Kurdistan region and Iraq participated. This workshop was sponsored by MHF.



## Submitting 5 thesis for 5 colleague students of Fine Art Institute in Sulaymaniyah

On 1<sup>st</sup> April 2021, MHF submitted “5” Thesis for 5 colleague students who studies at Fine Art institute in Sulaymaniyah aiming at increasing their ability to search and produce new theatrical workshop in their field of studying.

## Improving animal productivity by supplementary feeding and controlling feeding resources

Animal husbandry-controlled cultivation, management, and production of domestic animals, including improvement of the qualities considered desirable by human by means of breeding. Animals are bred and raised for utility such as “food, fur...”, for this reason and in order to improve the quality of animal feeding in colleges where animals are being raised, and students constantly have academic research on them, at the same time college of agricultural engineering was having shortage of feeding animals in their farms. MHF on the 6<sup>th</sup> of April 2021 for the purpose of helping local authorities. Offered assistance to the department of Animal science for the means of improving Animal productivity by supplementary feeding and controlling food resources.



## Honoring artists

MHF in partnership with voluntaries team in “Germany, Italy, and France” on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2021, launched a project rewarding Kurdish artists under the title of “Rewarding Homeless Artists” in Kurdistan, in this rewarding process an important prize was given to one of Kurdish artist whose name was “Rasho Zirak” who is a homeless artist living in Irbil.

## Signing MOU with the University of Raparin

On the 12<sup>th</sup> of April 2021, in University of Raparin a MOU was signed between MHF and the University of Raparin, in an effort to consolidate and support scientific and academic development, hoping that it would reflect positively on the scientific sector and the humanitarian fields in the coming stages.



## Yazidi New Year

On 2014 ISIS started a horrific attack on the Yazidis.

People fled to the nearby areas in order to save their lives, the majority of them came to the Ashti and Arbat camps within the Sulaymaniyah Governance. On the 15<sup>th</sup> of April 2021 and in the celebration of The Yazidi new year. MHF started the process of launching food packages for the Yazidi refugees in Ashti and Arbat camps.





## Provision of first aid kits to Kurdish Journalists in Sulaymaniyah

To assist and help journalists stay safe, MHF in partnership with Kurdistan Journalists Syndicate provided first aid kits to more than “400” journalists on the vocation of the world press Freedom Day 2021. The first aid kits contained a combination of “Adhesive Tape, antiseptic cleanser, bandages, Alcohol sanitizer, masks, gloves”.



## Provision of medical laborites to Kirkuk Cancer Hospital

To be able to enhance the health sector, MHF on the 26<sup>th</sup> of April 2021 in collaboration with the Kurdish Red Crescent started the process of providing modern medical laborites equipment which were essential to the clinical lab tests at Kirkuk Cancer Hospital, to support the health Units.

The Cancer Hospital of Kirkuk is one of the hospitals that faced medical laborites shortages. In order to save the lives of the patients in the hospital. MHF strengthened its commitment and proactively coordinated with Kirkuk authorities to respond to the shortages within the city, in this regard, MHF delivered 6 moderate medical laborites to the hospital.



## "Storytelling in Journalism: from Hard Data to Harder Narratives" Media Training Program

MHF in collaboration with Ronak Press sets up a media training course under the title of “Storytelling in Journalism: from hard data to harder narratives” for 160 journalists and college students on the 27<sup>th</sup> of April 2021 at Sulaymaniyah, Kirkuk, and Halabja”, governorates. The teachers of the course were successful professionals within their respective fields, such as journalism, photography and videography.

Ronak press is a non-profit based out of the Basque Country in Spain, it convenes world reporters working in print, photo and video to cover war stories from hotspots along the 33rd parallel from Western Sahara in Africa to Eastern Baluchistan in West Asia.

The lectures are journalists who work as reporters, photographers or camera operators in hostile environments. Their work has been published by the world’s leading newspapers, news agencies and TV channels such as The New York Times, The Washington Post, The Guardian, BBC, CNN, AP, AFP... Among several awards we can list two Emmy Awards (documentary), One World (documentary), Chris Hondros Memorial Award (photography), Picture of the Year (photography), NAB Reporting Award (journalism) and several other distinctions.

The objective of the course was to familiarize students with print journalism, including news features, and interviews. The course also aimed to assist the students to be able to reach a wider international audience. In the end of the course reliable certification were available for the participants.



### Honouring volunteers at Halabja Memorial Directorate

Within the frame of youth and development MHF on the 19<sup>th</sup> of May 2021, honored “7” volunteers who worked tirelessly at Halabja Memorial Directorate for 3 years. to show appreciation to their hard work. The main objective of this appreciating was to encourage more volunteers in local and nongovernmental organizations and local authorities in Kurdistan region.

### Singing MOU with Culture Factory Organization

On the 23<sup>th</sup> of May 2021 a MOU was signed between MHF and The Culture Factory in Sulaymaniyah. A MOU would allow development with the current intellectual movement in the area in the coming stages.





## Financial reports training course

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 2021, MHF in coordination with directorate of Iraqi- Non-Governmental organization launched a specialized course for the finance employees of the foundations and organization within Iraq, particularly in Kurdistan. Over “24” employees participated in this training course; the course was for “1” day. Hence, all the platforms that are essential was included in the training curriculum. As well as, preparing financial statement including the process of aggregating information into standardized set of financials.



## Publishing a book under the title of “Political Sociology” by Dr. Khudakaram Alzandi

On the 24<sup>th</sup> of May 2021 MHF sponsored the process of publishing a book by Dr. Khudakaram Alzandi, who is a lecturer in the college of humanities and social science in university of Sulaymaniyah. Political sociology is the study of the social organization of power. Consequently, this book focuses on the social causes and consequences of how power is distributed and changes throughout and amongst societies.



## Equipping air coolers to local authorities in the city of Sulaymaniyah

In line with supporting and sponsoring scientific and education sectors, MHF provided Air coolers to the schools and institutes in the city of the Sulaymaniyah. The distribution process included schools in “Zrgwery Bchwk school, Sherko Bekas high school for girls, Koya Institute, Yekety high school for girls, Zakya alkan school, Kurdistan educational compound”. This project aimed to encourage and assist students to comfortably finish their studies and decrease issues facing students.





## International Children's Day

MHF on the occasion of International Children's Day launched an event for the children within "Ashti, and Arbat" camps under the title of "Cinema can change our vision about life", MHF aims with this



activity to develop and enhance the knowledge of children about cinema and its genres in general. Through providing and distributing special gifts to the children. As its clearly known that many people who are living in the refugee camps suffers physically and mentally from the aftermath of the decades of conflict within their areas. Throughout this campaign MHF aimed to create an environment for the children to communicate with the outside world.

## Co-existence and peace
