MHF registered in Erbil on 23/01/2018 and registered in Baghdad on 02/02/2020. It has since then worked tirelessly to be able to provide protection to people in need during times of crisis and has had many Grass root-level Impacting activities.

Based on the principle of human rights and fundamental freedom, the foundation aims to educate the community on different fields such as cultural, social, economic, political, legal, health, educational, agricultural, environmental, tourism, and sports. Aiming to improve the employability and widen the understanding of the locals who take part. Such educational programs also support capacity building for locals.

MHF uses legal, humanitarian, and scientific means for development in the fields of Environmental awareness, cultural development, legal awareness, health, and education services. With the help of governmental institutions, local and foreign organizations. Our Team

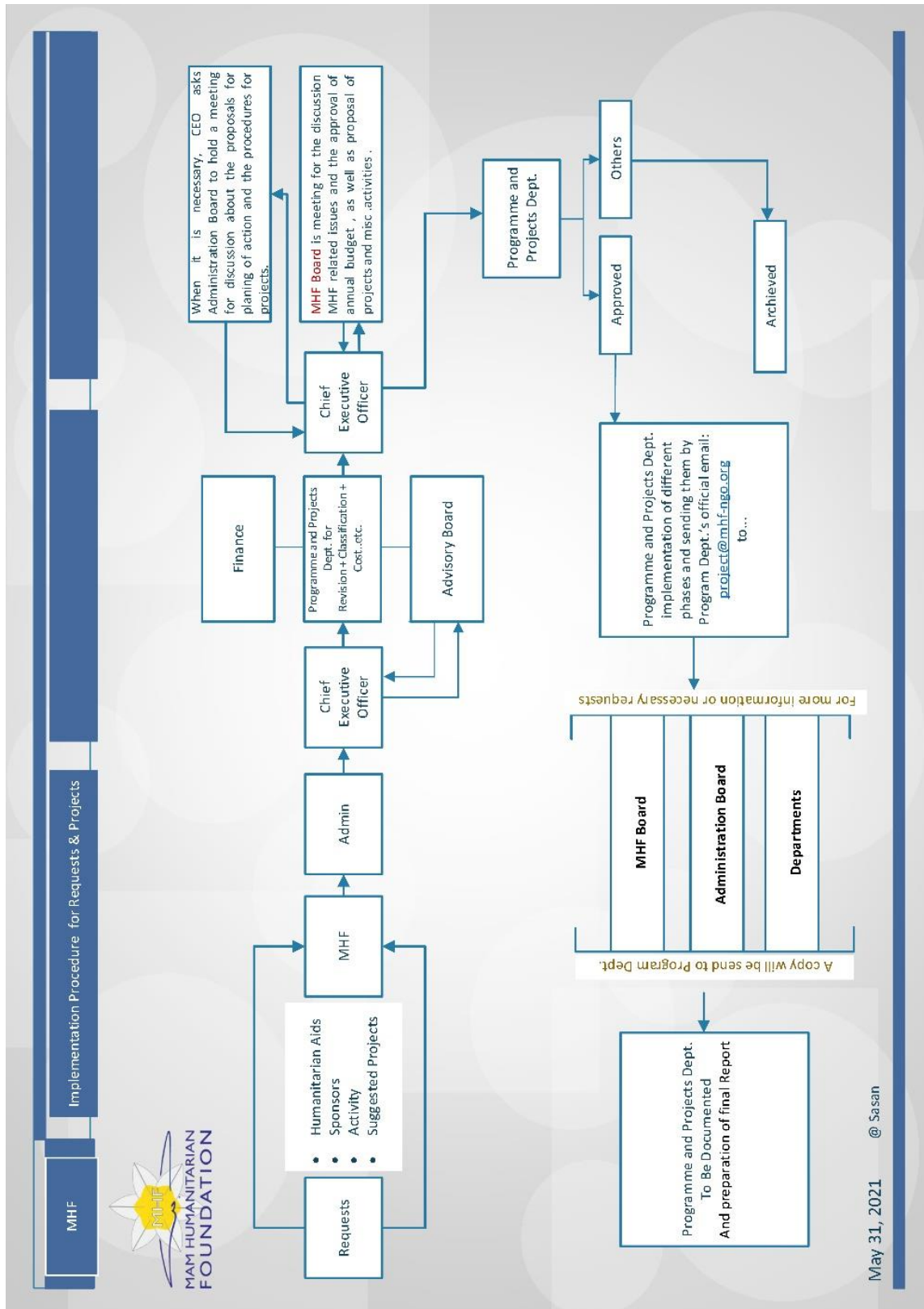

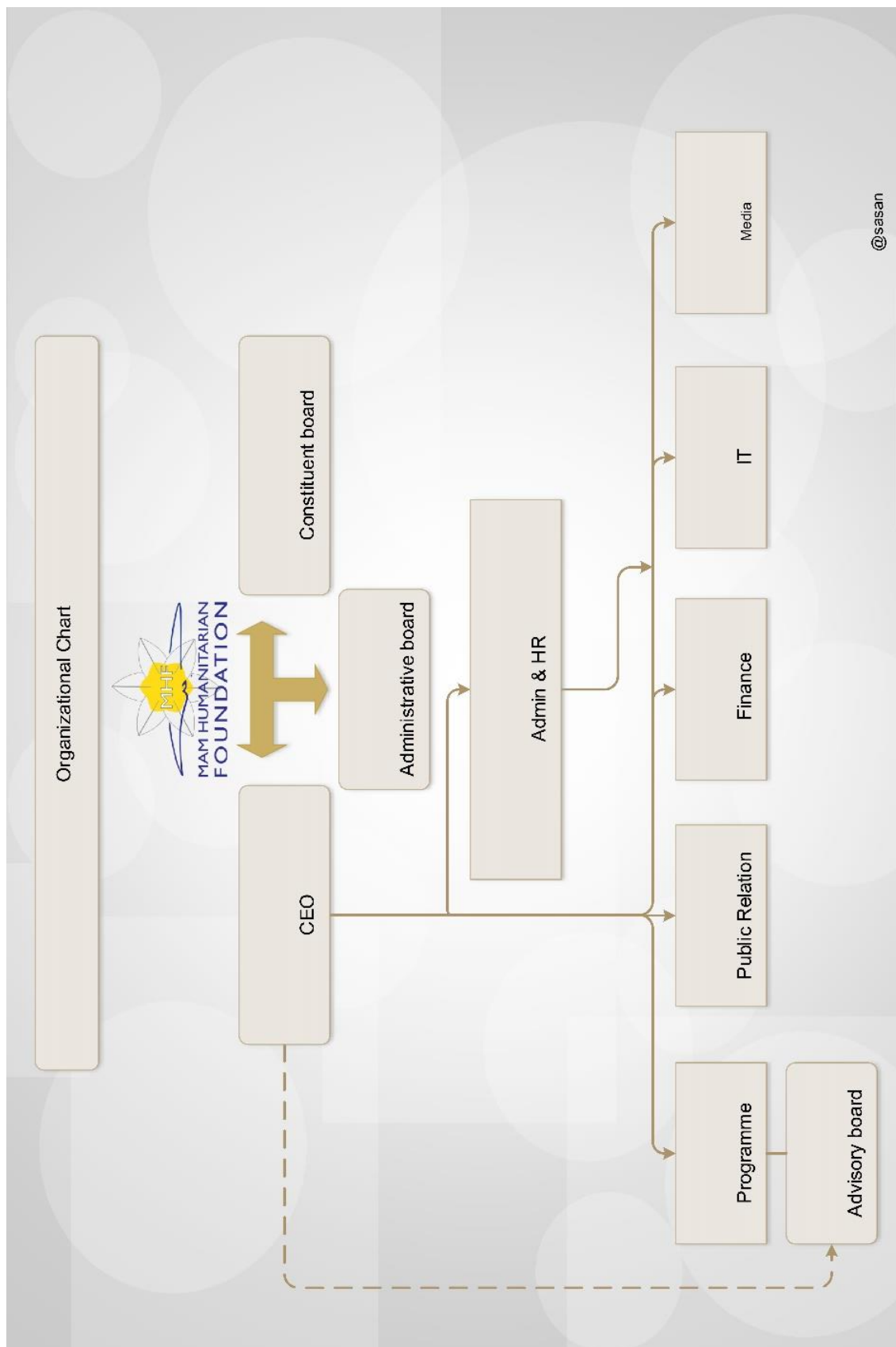
Project & Activity Path

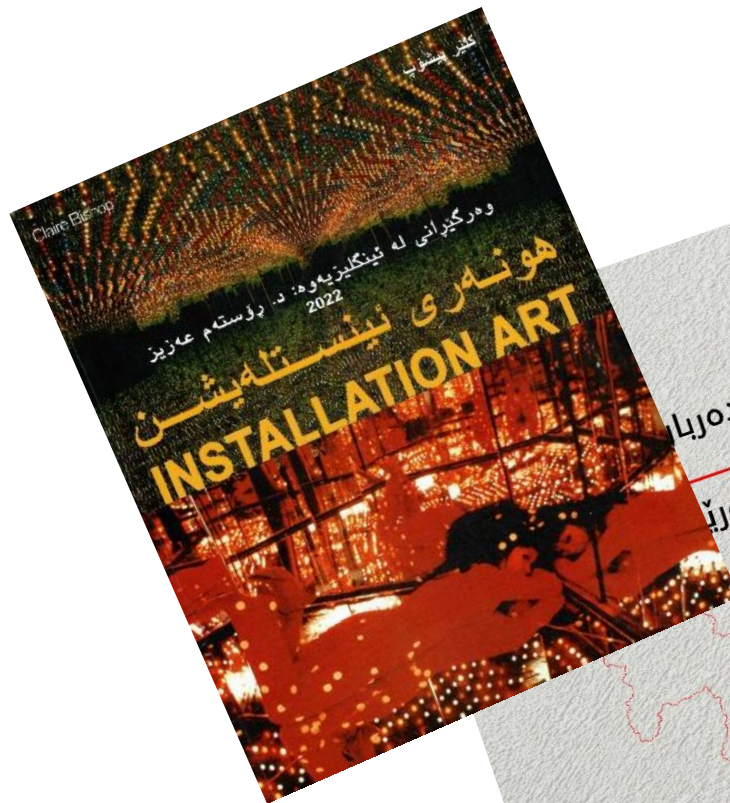
